

October 8, 2018

The Harper County Board of Commissioners met in regular session, with Chairman Lee Adams calling the meeting to order to Commissioner Carla Pence and Commissioner Brian Waldschmidt. Also in attendance was Melinda McCurley, Recording Secretary.

Resident Jarom Reeves was present during the public comment portion of the meeting to discuss the condition of his road just north of the new hospital construction site. The road has deteriorated due to recent heavy rains. John McClure will contact Bergkamp Construction for a solution.

Ami DeLacerda, HR, presented an updated Non-Discrimination/Anti-Harassment Policy. Commissioner Waldschmidt motioned to approve the policy change as presented; approved unanimously. A vacancy notice for dispatch was approved. There was continued discussion about repairs to the Anthony Road and Bridge shop.

John McClure, Road and Bridge/Solid Waste/Noxious Weeds, entered the meeting. The Board recommended that staff adhere to the 2010 Road Maintenance Plan and grade roads accordingly.

Melinda McCurley gave an update on the upcoming tax sale. Sixty-Eight (68) properties remain listed out of an original 106.

Commissioner Waldschmidt motioned to approve the regular meeting minutes of October 1, 2018; approved unanimously. Commissioner Pence motioned to approve payroll in the amount of \$139,156.44; approved unanimously.

Commissioner Pence left the meeting at 10:05 a.m.

The meeting recessed to the Health Department Basement to attend the Department Head Meeting. The regular meeting reconvened at 10:50am.

As there was no further business, the meeting adjourned at 10:50 a.m. The next regular meeting will be held on Monday, October 22nd, 2018 at 9 a.m. in the Courthouse Commissioner Room. The October 15th meeting was cancelled due to Commissioners attending the KAC (Kansas Association of Counties) Conference.
