The Harper County Board of Commissioners met in special session, with Chairman Pence calling the meeting to order to Commissioner Adams and Commissioner Waldschmidt. Human Resource Director, Ami DeLacerda, Health Officer Heather Struble, Deputy County Clerk, Kelsie Murphy and Recording Secretary Melinda McCurley were also in attendance.

Commissioner Adams motioned to approve Resolution 2020-12, a Resolution and Order relating to public health less stringent than the Kansas Governor's Executive Order No. 20-52 regarding the use of face masks and or other face coverings in public, within Harper County, Kansas making masks recommended and not mandatory; approved by Adams and Pence, Waldschmidt voted no, due to the fact that he does disagree with mandatory masks but that the County Commissioners shouldn't have to tell our citizens what to do. He indicated that it should be their choice and that County Commissioners should not be put in the position to overturn orders by the Governor.

As there was no further business, the meeting adjourned at 8:14 a.m. The next regular meeting will be held on Monday – July 6, 2020 at 9 a.m., in the Courthouse Commissioner Room.
